

**UNIVERSITY OF CONNECTICUT
BASKETBALL TICKET POLICIES FOR FACULTY / STAFF**

Adopted August 2000 by the President's Athletic Advisory Committee

Tickets will be offered via a University-wide lottery from **Monday, September 15th at 7:00am until Friday, September 19th at 5:00pm.**

All faculty and staff, as reported by the University's Department of Human Resources database, will be eligible. Emeriti are not eligible to purchase from the faculty / staff allotment, but they may purchase tickets through membership in The UConn Club.

The Division of Athletics annually reserves 366 Men's and Women's Basketball tickets for members of the University's faculty and staff. The President's Athletic Advisory Committee recommended a policy to give all members of the University's faculty and staff an equal opportunity to purchase tickets. It serves the important goal of giving the entire campus community a chance to participate in the success of our basketball programs.

In order to increase the availability of tickets to faculty and staff, no full season or single game tickets will be available. Seasons will be split into various mini plans for Men's Basketball games at Gampel Pavilion, Men's Basketball at the XL Center, Women's Basketball at Gampel Pavilion and Women's Basketball at the XL Center. Each package offered for a given venue will feature the same relative strength of opponents.

YOU MAY MAKE ONE ENTRY (TWO TICKETS MAXIMUM) INTO EACH OF THE SEPARATE LOTTERIES.

THE PROCESSING OF AN ORDER DOES NOT GUARANTEE AN ORDER WILL BE FILLED. IF ANY TICKET PACKAGE EXCEEDS THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF 366 THEN A LOTTERY WILL TAKE PLACE TO SELECT THE WINNERS. ANY NON WINNERS WILL BE REFUNDED IN FULL.

Faculty / staff lottery winners who are UConn Club members will be seated first, in order of priority points.

All faculty and staff members are welcomed and encouraged to purchase tickets through membership in The UConn Club, the donor organization that provides private support to our athletic program and offers special benefits to its members.
